



American Delirium Society Annual Meeting Abstract Submission Guidelines

Please see submission guidelines below: (One abstract per form)

- Abstract results must not have been published previously in a peer-reviewed publication.
- Must be submitted using a Microsoft Word Document.
- Limited to one page with imbedded graphics.
- Abstracts should be brief, typically less than 600 words and a 10 point Arial font should be used.
- Abstract margins should be set at 1" top and bottom and 1.25" left and right.
- Must be submitted using the online submission form.
- Abstracts are peer-reviewed according to the following criteria: originality, quality, clarity of message and significance of results.
- **Presenting authors are required to pay conference registration and expenses.**

SAMPLE:

Abstract Title: Text Should be Title Case (only using capital letters for principal words)

Presenting Author: First and Last Name, Degree(s), Affiliation

Co-Authors: First and Last Name, Degree(s), Affiliation (repeat as needed)

Abstract Sections Should be Organized via the Following Headings:

(Note, please do not include information that identifies author(s) or affiliation(s) in the body of your abstract submission)

- OBJECTIVE(s) – The hypothesis tested or purpose of the study.
- METHODS – Details of the study design/protocol.
- RESULTS – Results of the study with appropriate statistical inferences.
- CONCLUSIONS – Clinical importance and potential significance of findings.
